<input type="checkbox"/>	Hosting Agreement acc. To § 18d Residence Act – "Aufnahmevereinbarung gem. § 18d AufenthG, duly completed and signed by the German Research Facility / University and by you (If your highest degree is a Bachelor's Degree: Work Contract with the German Research Facility)
