



## RETHINKING – LEARNING FROM NATURE

### An educational exhibition on sustainable living

Water, fire, earth and air. Without these there is no life. People know this, and they have made use of the elements. The result was progress. But where are the limits of growth? Now that the natural equilibrium has been destabilised in many places – and has in some cases been lost forever – an era of rethinking has begun.

This interactive exhibition aims to raise awareness of environmental themes amongst young people worldwide. Each section of the exhibition is dedicated to one of the four elements (fire, water, earth and air), its significance and usefulness in nature and for human society. It examines the past, showcases the present and offers a glimpse into the future. Innovative technologies show that progress and environmental protection do not necessarily contradict each other and can coexist.

It also aims at inspiring visitors to continue to engage themselves with the topic of sustainable living – in their schools, in their families and in their neighborhood. Our website also offers materials and ideas on working with the topic in the classroom through projects and theme-based activities.

The exhibition is on a tour of South Asia and is being hosted by the Goethe-Institut / Max Mueller Bhavan in association with the German government initiative “Schools: Partners for the Future” (PASCH). It will be on view in Mumbai for two weeks in the month of July 2018. For students of our partner schools there will be guided tours along with a host of allied programmes.
