Germany fellowships for Indian journalists

The Robert Bosch Stiftung and the Center for Media Competence at the University of Tübingen for the last time would like to invite applications from Indian journalists for the fellowship program “Media Ambassadors India – Germany”. Successful candidates will visit Germany from June to August 2019.

Excellent Indian journalists can now apply for a fellowship as a part of the “Media Ambassadors India – Germany” program. The term media ambassadors (“Medienbotschafter”) expresses the program partners’ aim to strengthen international understanding between India and Germany through journalism exchange.

Successful program applicants will travel from June to August 2019 to Germany. The fellowship covers an allowance of 1600 Euros per month and all travel expenses associated with the program. The program in a nutshell: Eight Indian fellows complete a twelve-week stay in Germany. The stay includes a customised academic media and area studies course at the Center for Media Competence at the Eberhard Karls University of Tübingen, an extensive cultural program, a field trip in Germany and a newsroom stint with an editorial department of a leading German media outlet.

The fellowship is open to journalists from the areas of print, online, radio, and television media who have proof of professional excellence and of interest in Indo- German relations. German language skills are not necessary, but of advantage. There is no age limit.

After completion of the program, fellows have a range of possibilities to further strengthen the relations between German and Indian journalists through an alumni network.
