Attestation of Documents

Upon presentation of the originals, documents can be attested by the German Consulate General Mumbai. A copy of a non-authenticated document cannot be certified.

An appointment is not required for the attestation. Applicants may submit their documents during the opening hours of the consular section, i.e. Monday to Thursday, 9:00 am to 11:00 am.

Documents required

- Valid passport
- All original documents that need to be attested
- As many copies of all documents as required (front and back side, unstapled)

Fees

A minimum fee of 10 EUR (approx. 800 INR depending on the exchange rate) is charged per document to be attested. The exact fee depends upon the number of pages to be attested.

The above mentioned fee is charged for documents that comprise up to ten pages. Any additional page will be charged 1 EUR (approx. 100 INR depending on the exchange rate).

The fee is to be paid in cash in Indian Rupees or with a German credit card (MasterCard or Visa).

Attestation of documents required for studies in Germany

A student intending to study in Germany is entitled to a maximum of three sets of documents free of charge. Apart from the documents mentioned above, applicants must present the following:

- Proof of residence in the jurisdiction of the Consulate (e.g. recent enrolment letter of a school, college or university, lease agreement, passport or Aadhaar Card)
- Copy of correspondence with the intended universities
- List of required documents given by the university

Please note:

1. Any person failing to present a proof of residence cannot be attended.
2. In case no proof of intention of studying in Germany is being submitted, the above mentioned fees will be charged.
