- CKFSL Blocked Accounts -

As part of your student visa application, you are required to provide the proof of sufficient funds to cover your living expenses in Germany.

One option to fulfil this requirement is to open a Blocked Account through Cox & Kings Financial Service Ltd. (CKFSL) in India who will facilitate you to open Blocked Account in Germany.

You can contact CKFSL in India and request opening of a Blocked Account before applying your student visa for Germany.

You can conveniently pay the required blocked amount directly to CKFSL in Indian Rupees. Your Blocked Account will be opened in Germany in Euro currency and operated by Commerzbank AG in Germany.

After your arrival in Germany, you are required to activate your Blocked Account to receive your monthly withdrawal directly to your local savings bank account held in Germany.

Please submit the Blocked Amount confirmation issued by CKFSL of minimum Euro 10,236 during your visa interview.
