For the application you require the following documents:

<input type="checkbox"/>	Valid passport (issued within the last 10 years and with at least two empty pages)
<input type="checkbox"/>	Application form & declaration (in accordance with Section 54 of the Residence Act) duly signed (2 copies)
<input type="checkbox"/>	Declaration for Additional contact and legal representation information (2 copies)
<input type="checkbox"/>	3 current, identical biometric passport photos
<input type="checkbox"/>	Copy of your passport's data page (A4 size copy) (2 copies)
<input type="checkbox"/>	Annexure for employment visa – two completed copies
<input type="checkbox"/>	Declaration in regards to § 18 AufenthG
<input type="checkbox"/>	“Declaration regarding a contract of employment” (Erklärung zum Beschäftigungsverhältnis), completed and duly signed by the employer
<input type="checkbox"/>	Proof of academic qualifications , e. g. Master's Degree, Bachelor's Degree
<input type="checkbox"/>	Proof that your studies done in presence or, if done remotely, confirmation by the relevant Indian authority that this distance learning was approved at the time of your degree.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Proof of recognition of your academic qualification in Germany: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - 2 copies from the Anabin website of the recognition of the academic degree as well as the University (Degree mentioned as “entspricht” or “gleichwertig”, University mentioned as “H+”,) OR <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Original and 2 copies of the recognition (“Zeugnisbewertung”) of the non-german degree by the Central Office for Foreign Education, ZAB (Zentralstelle für ausländisches Bildungswesen).
<input type="checkbox"/>	If applicable: Professional practice license (Berufsausübungserlaubnis) issued by the relevant recognition body in original and 2 copies For certain regulated professions, a professional practice license is required, for example for medical doctors, engineers, teachers etc.
<input type="checkbox"/>	If you meet Blue Card requirements or are unsure: Declaration in regards to § 82 AufenthG
<input type="checkbox"/>	If applicable: Pre-Approval by the Federal Employment Agency NOT applicable for a salary above 48.300,-- € annually
<input type="checkbox"/>	Curriculum Vitae
<input type="checkbox"/>	For applicants who are 45 years old or older and whose yearly salary is below 53.130,-- €: document of proof of adequate contribution to a German Pension fund / pension insurance
<input type="checkbox"/>	Confirmation of compulsory health insurance and/or Travel Health Insurance

All documents need to be presented in original plus TWO copies (A4 size).
