For the application you require the following documents:

	Valid <b>passport</b> (issued within the last 10 years and with at least two empty pages
	Application form & declaration (in accordance with Section 54 of the Residence Act) duly signed (2 copies)
	<b>Declaration</b> for Additional contact and legal representation information (2 copies)
	3 current, identical biometric passport photos
	Copy of your passport's data page (A4 size copy) (2 copies)
	Annexure for employment visa – two completed copies
	Declaration in regards to § 18 AufenthG
	"Declaration regarding a contract of employment" (Erklärung zum
	Beschäftigungsverhältnis), cmpleted and duly signed by the employer
	Proof of academic qualifications, e. g. Master's Degree, Bachelor's Degree
	Proof that your studies done in presence or, if done remotely, confirmation by the relevant
	Indian authority that this distance learning was approved at the time of your degree.
	<ul> <li>Proof of recognition of your academic qualification in Germany:</li> <li>2 copies from the <u>Anabin website</u> of the recognition of the academic degree as well as the University (Degree mentioned as "entspricht" or "gleichwertig", University mentioned as "H+",)</li> <li>OR</li> <li>Original and 2 copies of the recognition ("Zeugnisbewertung") of the non-german degree by the Central Office for Foreign Education, ZAB (<u>Zentralstelle für ausländisches</u>)</li> </ul>
	Bildungswesen). If applicable: Professional practice license (Berufsausübungserlaubnis) issued by the relevant recognition body in original and 2 copies For certain regulated professions, a professional practice license is required, for example for medical doctors, engineers, teachers etc.
	If you meet Blue Card requirements or are unsure: Declaration in regards to § 82 AufenthG
	If applicable: <b>Pre-Approval</b> by the Federal Employment Agency NOT applicable for a salary above 48.300, € annually
	Curriculum Vitae
	For applicants who are <b>45 years old or older</b> and whose yearly salary is below 53.130, €: document of proof of adequate contribution to a German Pension fund / pension insurance
	Confirmation of <b>compulsory health insurance</b> and/or <b>Travel Health</b> Insurance

All documents need to be presented in original plus TWO copies (A4 size).

Submission of incomplete documentation or refusal to appear for a visa interview may result in the rejection of your application.
